

COMMUNITY RENEWABLE ENERGY PROJECTS



Renewable Energy Projects funded to date include:

- **Ocombe Farm Wind Turbine Project:** Funded the professional survey and assessment for the Torbay Coast & Countryside Trust wind turbine at Ocombe Farm.
- **Pilling St John's Primary School – wind turbine project:** assistance with the funding of the installation of a wind turbine at the school, providing energy and income to the school.
- **National Star College – Biomass Installation:** the installation of a centrally located Biomass boiler system distributing heat and hot water to a college for severely disabled young people.
- **Worcester Wildlife Trust – Geothermal Heating System:** installation of a Geothermal Heating system at the Education Centre – enabling the WWT to use the centre all year round and providing an illustration of sustainable technology in action.
- **The Wind Fund/Triodos Renewables:** a limited company set up to invest in wind power infrastructure to meet demand for electricity generation from renewable energy resources through the governments' Non Fossil Fuel Obligation (NFFO).
- **Good Energy:** The Naturesave Trust invested in shares in Good Energy, the Renewable Energy electricity company.
- **Transition Town Clitheroe – Whalley Hydro Project:** A community hydro project in Lancashire. The Trust has funded an ecological survey.
- **Kingussie Community Development Company:** The Trust provided a grant towards the Abstraction License for a micro-hydro project in the Highlands of Scotland.
- **Whittlesford Memorial Hall:** The trust has offered funding towards the installation of solar panels in the community village hall.

Projects ongoing:

- **Cornish Renewable Energy Ltd:** a renewable energy cooperative of 9 farmers setting up wind turbines on their farms. The Trust has pledged support towards the cost of the cabling for these turbines.
- **Hope Daycare Ltd:** the Trust has pledged funding towards the installation of a Ground Source Heat Pump at the Bromyard Multi use centre in Herefordshire.
- **Tintern Angiddy Project (T.A.P.):** the Trust has pledged funds towards a site survey and some of the infrastructure for a hydro scheme in Monmouthshire.
- **Crickhowell High School:** the Trust has offered funding towards the installation of a solar photovoltaic system for this school in Powys.
- **Dalwood Community Shop Association:** the Trust has offered a grant to this community shop towards the installation of a solar PV system.
- **North Petherwin Church Micro-wind Turbine:** the Trust has offered a grant towards the infrastructure and connection to the grid.
- **Ardishaig Community Trust:** a community wind turbine project in Argyll. The Trust has offered a grant towards the wind yield assessment report.
- **The Wharf House:** a solar photovoltaic project in Gloucestershire. The Trust has offered a grant towards the cost of the photovoltaic panels.
- **Bath Community Energy Ltd:** The Trust has offered a grant towards a community hydro scheme at Bathampton Weir.
- **Green Energy Aware Twechar:** The Trust has offered a grant towards the cost of a solar photovoltaic installation at the Healthy Living and Enterprise Centre in Twechar in Scotland.
